## October 2020 Show Cancellation Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Are we going back to a 3 day show?
  - The Eastern Division Board of Directors voted to change the April & October 2021 York Shows to 3 days.
- 2. What will happen to the registration fee I paid for April 2020?
  - All April & October 2020 registration fees are being forwarded to the April 2021 Show.

3. If I registered for the April &/or October 2020 Show, do I need to register again for the April 2021Show?

- No, you do not need to register again for the April 2021 Show.
- 4. I didn't register for either the April or October 2020 Shows. Now what?
  - If you did not register for the April or October 2020 Shows you will need to do so. You may use the registration form located in the April 2021 Meet Notice, the TCA National Headquarters Newsletter or located on our website at <u>https://www.easterntca.com/</u> <u>member.htm</u> or <u>https://www.easterntca.com/dealers.htm</u>
- 5. Will I receive a new badge?

• <u>No</u>, you will <u>not</u> receive a new badge. Both colored (April & October) badges will be permitted entry into the halls at the April 2021 Show.

- 6. Will I receive an April 2021 Meet notice?
  - No; however you will receive a reminder notice.
- 7. Do I have to be with my guest when they register?
  - No, you do not need to be with your guest when they register.
- 8. Do I need to have a sponsor to register as a guest?
  - Yes, you need a sponsor. If you don't have one, you may still register at the Registration Desk, located in the Silver (Memorial) Hall and a TCA member of the Registration Staff will sponsor you as a guest.
- 9. Do I have to stay with my guest during the entire show?

• <u>No</u>, but you are responsible for educating your guest in the rules of the meet.

- 10. Do I need a new badge each day? No, the badge is good for the entire show.
- 11. What is the difference between a guest and the public? A guest registers to attend in the Silver Hall (Registration Desk) and has access to all the halls, including Member Halls (Silver, Red, Blue, White) for the entire 3 day show.

The public pays daily admission at the Orange Hall ticket booth and is permitted access to the Dealer Halls (Orange & Purple) and layouts in the Black Hall only for Friday & Saturday.

12. <u>I am unable to attend the April 2021 meet.</u> What happens to my registration money from the April 2020 show?

 Your April or October 2020 fee will be forwarded to the April 2021 show <u>only</u>.
